



## Cengage CNOWv2 - Student Access (template)

In order to access Cengage CNOWv2 resources, please follow the steps below.


1. After logging into your Los Rios D2L course, click on the Content link to access your Cengage Learning Resources.




2. When in the Content area, you should see a Cengage Learning Resources module. Clicking on that module will let you see the Cengage activities your instructor has linked to the D2L course.



3. After clicking on the specific Cengage activity you are attempting to access, if this is your first time accessing Cengage (or first time in this course) you will be prompted to login or create a Cengage account.



4. After logging in or creating an account, you will then be asked to choose in what way you would like to be granted access to the course.




**\*\* Important Note** – you will have the option to either enter your access code (or purchase a new one), or to apply for free, temporary access.

Should you choose to

enter the access code from the textbook you may affect the ability to return the book if you later decide the class will not work for you, so you may want to check your school bookstore's policy before making this decision. \*\*
