

Connect to Exchange 2010 with Mac OS X Mail

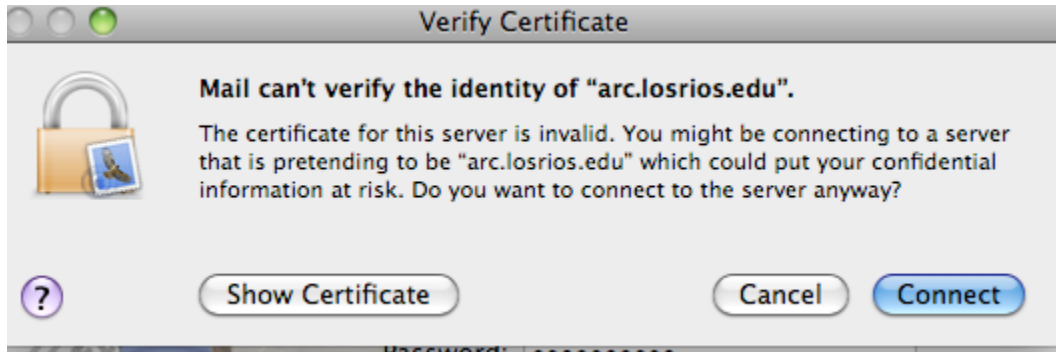
Special Note: This functionality is new to Mac OS X 10.6 (Snow Leopard).

1. Open the mail application.
2. Under the "Mail" pull down menu, choose Preferences.
3. Click the "+" symbol to add a mail account.
4. Fill in your full name, email address, and the password you use to log into a work computer.



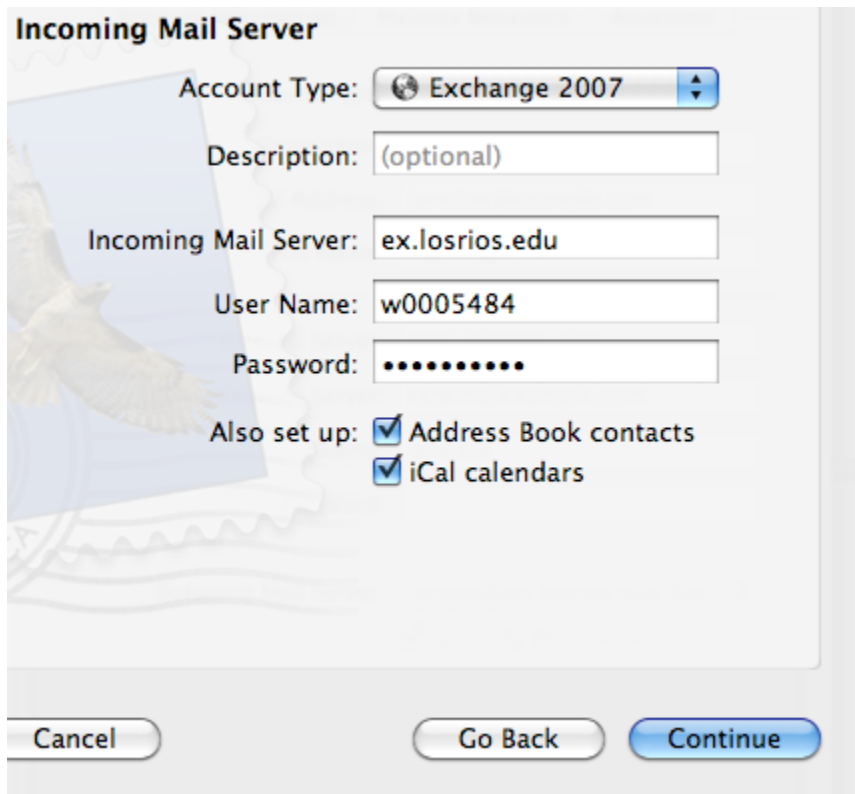
5. Click the "Continue" button.

6. It will search the Internet for the LRCCD mail server. When it resolves, a warning may come up about the certificate not being valid.



7. The warning is OK. Click the "Connect" button.

8. It will now ask for "Incoming Mail Server" information. Fill it in as below, replacing with your work W number and work password.



9. Click the "Continue" button.

10. Click the "Create" button.

11. Close the "Preferences" window.

12. In the bottom-right of the Mail screen you will see a mail activity icon. Be patient, it may take a few minutes for your mail to start showing the first time.
